### Gleann Fhinne Night at the Races

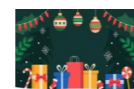
C.L.G Ghleann Fhinne Bord na nOg Christmas Tractor Run: With just under 100 days to Christmas CLG Ghleann Fhinne.

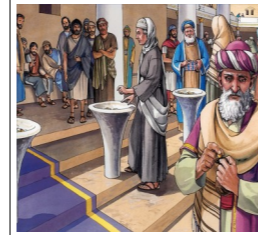
### Bazaar 2024

### Thoughts on the Gospel for

**The Thirty-Second Sunday—Year B November 10th 2024**

We live in a very image-conscious society. Status, respect and 'face' are very important. How we are seen is more important than who we really are. The scribes and Pharisees are presented today as very image-conscious. It was more important to be seen and thought of as good and holy than to be really so. In today's Gospel, Jesus says: *Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes and to be greeted with respect in the marketplaces and to have the best seats in the synagogues and places of honour at banquets!* In fact, scribes, as interpreters of the Law, were deeply respected for their great learning. They wore long white robes as a sign of their devotion to the Law. People were supposed to stand in their presence and greet them with titles like 'Master' or 'Father'. The problem was that they began to feel that such respect was a right, and this was accompanied by arrogance and pomposity. The respect for God's Law, they began to arrogate for themselves.

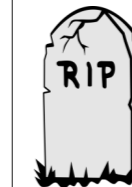

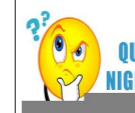
