




Thoughts on the Gospel for





There are many strange names in today's Gospel. They are the names of people and places most of us have never heard of. Why does Luke mention these people and places? First of all, because he is simply following the custom of his day both for Jewish and Greek writing. But more im-

portantly, he is saying that the story of John the Baptist and of Jesus is really historical. This story really happened in this world at a particular time and a particular place. It is not a mere myth in the sense of a story which has meaning, but no basis in fact. Luke is preparing us for the announcement of God coming among us as a human being. He is preparing the stage for this great drama and provides:-the time this going exact happen; -the political situation (Palestine was a colony of the Roman Empire); -the religious situation (Annas and Caiaphas were high priests); -the place (a small province in the eastern part of the Empire). Any modern history of those times will corroborate the facts that Luke gives.
